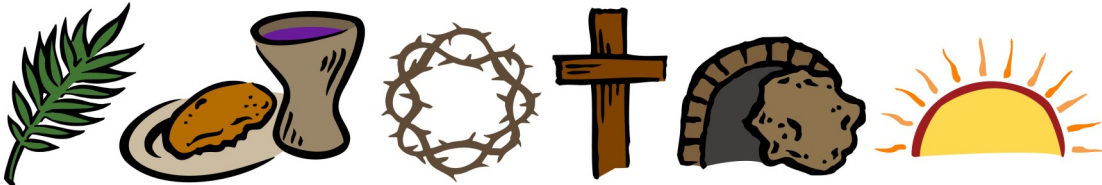

March will be a busy month and there are two things I want to highlight. First is our **College and Career group** starting on March 3rd. March is the month we observe a Week of Prayer for North American Missions and receive the Annie Armstrong Easter

Offering. Prayer guides will be in the bulletin and we encourage you to pray for the featured missionaries throughout the month.

The letters WMU stand for Woman's Missionary Union but WMU is for everyone. We especially invite all women of the church to join us on the second Tuesday of each month as we meet to pray for missionaries, learn about a particular area of mission work, and plan missions projects.



PBC Kids have grown in their relationships with God in the last few months. Tristan, Ashton and Mikael accepted Jesus over the holidays and were baptized on February 18th!!!! The activity for February was making Valentines for families and friends.

We have started a **new Wednesday curriculum** which includes one week of missions with Missions Journey Kids and the remaining weeks are dedicated to learning more from the Bible, using the widely known and used Noah's Park Blue Edition. The revamping of the children's church was with intent to

keep kids fully engaged, provide Biblical knowledge as well as focus on missionaries and how they are called to help others worldwide. We have also added a preschool group to Wednesday nights. Three- to 5-year-olds will have the same weekly rotation of missions and Bible stories, as their older peers. I am happy to say that the changes have been received well by the children so far and I am thankful for how the volunteers have adapted.

As **Easter** falls on March 31st this year, we will hold the **He Is Risen, Easter Egg Hunt** on 3/30. The Youth will host a **bake sale** within the event and are looking for volunteers to donate baked goods or assistance in managing sale. We have begun collecting eggs, filled (preferred) and unfilled. Baked goods needed by noon on Friday, 3/29. Stay tuned for more details on how you can help.

The **Youth group** participated in this year's Valentines Day banquet. They created the lovely center pieces for the tables and served the Valentine Banquet dinner. It has been delightful to see the interactions with the youth and elders of this church family. We saw a bit of growth in February as there have been some repeat visitors in the High School class. The Youth group teamed up against each other the last weekend of February in an escape room challenge. It was a great night of fellowship.
